Bald Eagle, Green Herons, and Kingfishers have been spotted here. We will also learn more about the unique ecosystems that are freshwater marshes.

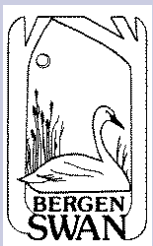
